**Re:** Port Angeles Main Library to get new carpet during renovation

The Port Angeles Main Library will be undergoing renovations August 21 through September 8. The renovation project will focus on replacing nearly 6,000 square feet of worn carpet, as well as repairing and painting walls as needed. The library will remain open throughout the project with some service limitations.

During the project, parts of the library's fiction, nonfiction, biography and young adult collections will be unavailable for short periods. Patrons are encouraged to continue placing holds on material from Port Angeles and other branches during the renovation. Approximately half of the library's 32 public computers will be unavailable throughout a majority of the project. Wi-Fi access, express computers with a 15 minute limit, circulating iPads, and digital microfilm reader computers will remain available. Other areas of the library will remain open and operate as usual during the renovation project.

The renovation project, estimated to cost \$27,000, is a planned project under NOLS' Ten Year Capital Plan, funded as part of the North Olympic Library System's 2017 Capital Improvement budget.
