Weekly Storytimes for toddlers, preschoolers, and babies will resume on Wednesday, September 13 at the Sequim Branch of the North Olympic Library System! On Wednesdays, Preschool Storytime will take place at 10:30am and Baby Storytime will be held at 2pm. Wiggly Storytime will be offered at 10:30am each Thursday. A new Evening Storytime will also offer an opportunity for busy families to attend on the first and third Tuesday of the month at 6:30pm. After each session, attendees will have an opportunity to visit and swap information about parenting and education resources in the community.

- Baby Storytime features fun action songs and nursery rhymes, with time for parents and caregivers to meet and visit after each session.
- Wiggly Storytime caters to little ones who are moving around on their own. There will be plenty of action songs and activities designed to let them learn while they get their move on!
- Preschool Storytime programs include stories, music, rhymes, and action songs that will get children excited about learning.
- Evening Storytime is a chance for busy families to enjoy storytime together. Children will enjoy a few books, laugh and wiggle to some rhymes and songs, and are welcome to wear their PJs to the library!
