Re: Sequim Branch Library Community Open House on Branch Expansion

The North Olympic Library System (NOLS) is currently engaged in a broad community conversation regarding the overcrowded spaces and aging infrastructure of the Branch Library serving the Sequim-Dungeness Valley. Originally built in 1983, the Sequim Branch Library facility is cramped and aging. The Library Board and staff are seeking a solution to better serve Sequim – Dungeness Valley residents, but they can't do it alone. A Conceptual Design Open House will be held on **Monday, November 6 from 4-6pm**. Stop by and share your ideas for an Expanded Sequim Branch Library. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend this Conceptual Design Open House led by NOLS' consultants, SHKS Architects.

The library is currently engaged in Phase 2 of the Sequim Branch Library expansion project. This Conceptual Design phase will help determine community priorities for an expanded library, develop a solid cost estimate, and produce a schematic design for an expanded library at the current location at 630 N. Sequim Ave.

A second community input session will take place on Saturday, December 2. The schedule for December 2 activities will be announced in early November.
