The North Olympic Library System (NOLS) is currently engaged in a broad community conversation regarding the overcrowded spaces and aging infrastructure of the Sequim Branch Library serving the Sequim-Dungeness Valley. Originally built in 1983, the Sequim Branch Library facility is cramped and aging. The library is now in Phase 2 of the Sequim Branch Library expansion project. This Conceptual Design phase will help determine community priorities for an expanded library, develop a solid cost estimate, and produce a schematic design for an expanded library at the current location at 630 N. Sequim Ave. The Library Board and staff are seeking a solution to better serve Sequim – Dungeness Valley residents, but they can't do it alone. 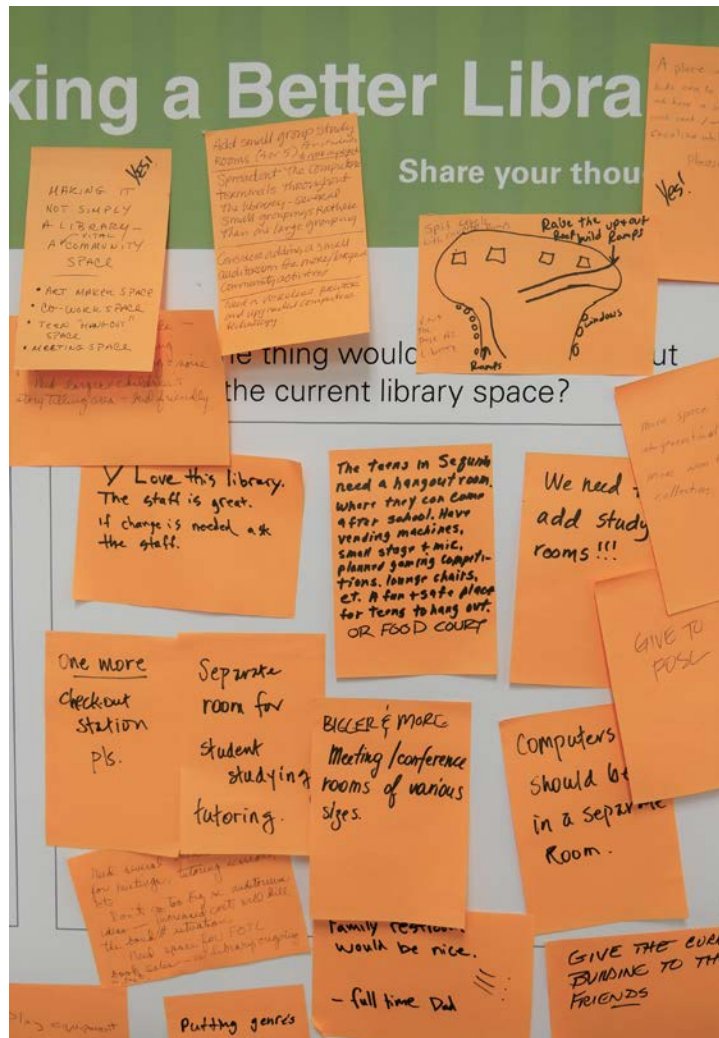
