Weekly Storytimes for preschoolers, wiggles, and babies will resume on Wednesday, January 3 at the Sequim Branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS). *Wiggly Storytime* for children ages 1 to 3 years will be offered at 10:30am every Thursday; *Preschool Storytime* for ages 3-5 will take place at 10:30am every Wednesday; and *Baby Storytime* for ages 0-12 months will be held at 2pm every Wednesday. Be sure to check out the newly added *Evening Storytime*, for families, on the first and third Tuesdays at 6:30pm. All age recommendations for each storytime are guidelines; all children are welcome at any time!

- *Baby Storytime* features fun action songs and nursery rhymes with time for parents and caregivers to meet and visit after each session.
- *Preschool Storytime* programs include age-appropriate books, music, rhymes, and action songs that will get them excited about learning.
- *Wiggly Storytime* caters to littles who are just learning to move around on their own. There will be plenty of action songs and activities that are designed to let them learn while they get their move on!
- *Evening Storytime* is a chance for busy families to enjoy storytime together. Children will enjoy a few stories, laugh and wiggle to some rhymes and songs, and have fun wearing their PJs to the library!
