The *Family Flicks* movie series begins 2018 with another season of great family entertainment at the Sequim Branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS). Offered at 2pm on the first Saturday of every month through April, *Family Flicks* provides fun family entertainment, popcorn, and movie trivia at an affordable price—free!

The series kicks off 2018 with a screening of ***The Lego Batman Movie*** at 2pm on Saturday, January 6. Released in 2017, this PG-rated film is a celebration of everything Batman. The movie makes numerous references to previous *Batman* movies, cartoons and comics. This film presents a cooler-than-ever Bruce Wayne who must deal with the usual suspects as they plan to rule Gotham City, while discovering that he has accidentally adopted a teenage orphan who wishes to become his sidekick. If Batman wants to save the city from The Joker's hostile takeover, he may have to drop the lone vigilante thing, try to work with others, and maybe learn to lighten up. This film is a must-see for Batman fans!

On Saturday, February 3, ***Cars 3*** will hit the screen. This film was produced in 2017 by Walt Disney Pictures' Pixar. Blindsided by a new generation of blazing-fast cars, Lightning McQueen finds himself pushed out of the sport that he loves. Hoping to regain a competitive edge, he turns to Cruz Ramirez, an eager young technician who has her own plans for winning as well as to the late Fabulous Hudson Hornet for inspiration. This film is G-rated.

The series will continue on March 3 with PG-rated **Despicable Me 3**. After he is fired from the Anti-Villain League for failing to take down the latest bad guy to threaten humanity, Gru finds himself in the midst of a major identity crisis. But, when a mysterious stranger shows up to inform Gru that he has a long-lost twin brother, a brother who desperately wishes to follow in his twin's despicable footsteps, one former super-villain will rediscover just how good it feels to be bad.






