The first annual *REthink! Fair* will explore ways that organizations and the community can make a difference through *REducing, REfusing, REusing, REcycling* and ultimately *REthinking*. Visit the Port Angeles Main Library between 11am and 4pm on Saturday, May 12, to learn about new ways to conserve resources. Create with recycled objects. Connect with local agencies. See how simple changes can make a big difference in your environmental footprint.

This program is a partnership between the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Association, Olympic Coast National Marine Sanctuary, Clallam County Waste Prevention Program and the North Olympic Library System. Several community partners including Coastsavers, Surfriders, Feiro Marine Life Center, Peninsula College - Composites Technologies, and Olympic National Park will have interactive stations and activities to explore. Activities will range from writing a break up letter to plastics and learning about beach cleanups, to creating a repurposed book craft and testing out a pickle ball paddle made out of recycled materials.
