The program was inspired by StoryCorps, an organization focused on the collecting, sharing, and preserving of oral histories. *Listen Up!* interviews are conducted with the participant and an interview

partner. Completed recordings are later archived and become available for listening on the Washington State Library's Washington Rural Heritage website, and are also available at nols.org/listenup. Dozens of audio recordings and special compilation videos from past *Listen Up!* topics have already been preserved for posterity.
