Sequim Farmers Market

Railroad Bridge Park

Thursday, July 26, 10:30am

Enjoy river sounds and bird songs at an outdoor storytime in the Railroad Bridge Park amphitheater. The Dungeness River Audubon Center will also be open to visitors for families to enjoy and trails abound just waiting to be explored. Close parking is limited; additional parking is available at entrance to the park. Participants should be prepared for a short walk to the amphitheater.

More About the Summer Reading Program


The theme for the 2018 Summer Reading Program is *Libraries Rock!* This summertime celebration, which encourages children to keep reading during the summer break from school, features a reading challenge and a multitude of events for all ages. Research shows that children who do not read during the summer experience “summer slide” and may lose up to a month of the instructional knowledge they gained during the previous school year. Library summer reading programs have been shown to help alleviate the “summer slide” by providing access to books, enrichment activities, and encouraging young people to keep reading. The 2018 Summer Reading Program runs June 16 through August 18.
