Join family performer & teaching artist Andy Furgeson of Red Yarn for a special puppet-building workshop. Build a puppet on Tuesday, July 17, 4:30pm at the Forks Branch Library. Puppet creating continues on Wednesday, July 18, 4pm at the Port Angeles Main Library. The final workshop will be on Thursday, July 19, 1pm at the Sequim Branch Library. Registration is required for all workshops.

Participants will build elaborate animal puppets from paper, foam, fabric & yarn and will learn puppetry techniques to put their new puppets to use!
