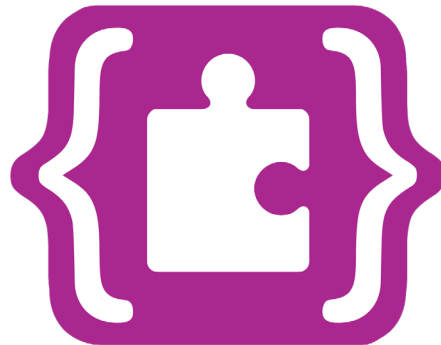

During the Hour of Code™ event at the Port Angeles Main Library, teens 13 and older can join in a MakeCode™ “petting zoo” with BBC Microbits!

The 'Hour of Code™' is a nationwide initiative by Computer Science Education Week (csedweek.org) and Code.org to introduce millions of students to one hour of computer
