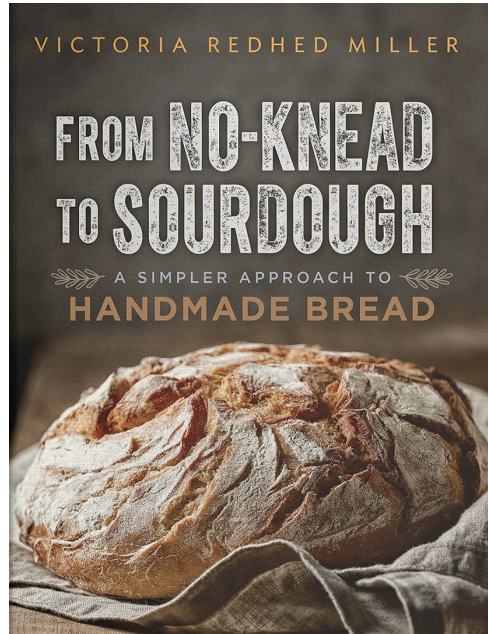

In her newest book, she blends her own journey toward self-reliance with her fascination for traditional homesteading skills and love of good food.
