Forks Branch Library: Saturday, June 1

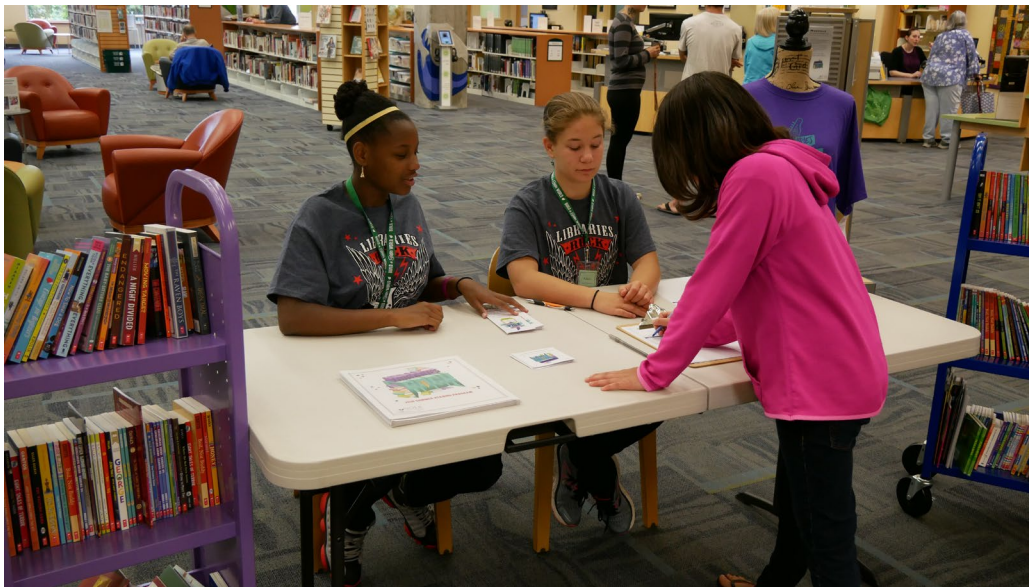
Port Angeles Main Library: Friday, June 21 (Wednesday, June 12 for Teen Leaders)
