Second Saturday Science: Geology Rocks! will be offered at the Sequim Branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS) on Saturday, March 14 at 10:30am. The Second Saturday Science series—for ages 7 to 12—creates fun, hands-on opportunities for children to explore concepts related to science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). Unearthing and identifying dinosaur bones, predicting hurricanes and tornadoes, exploring mines, discovering a hidden city, working with water quality, and panning for gold are exciting earth sciences career paths for students to imagine pursuing. This program will offer hands-on exploration of various rock specimens and a demonstration of gold panning with Garret Romaine, Executive Director of the Rice Northwest Museum of Rocks and Minerals. Romaine is the author of several geology-related books including *Geology Lab for Kids* and *Modern Rockhounding & Prospecting Handbook*.
