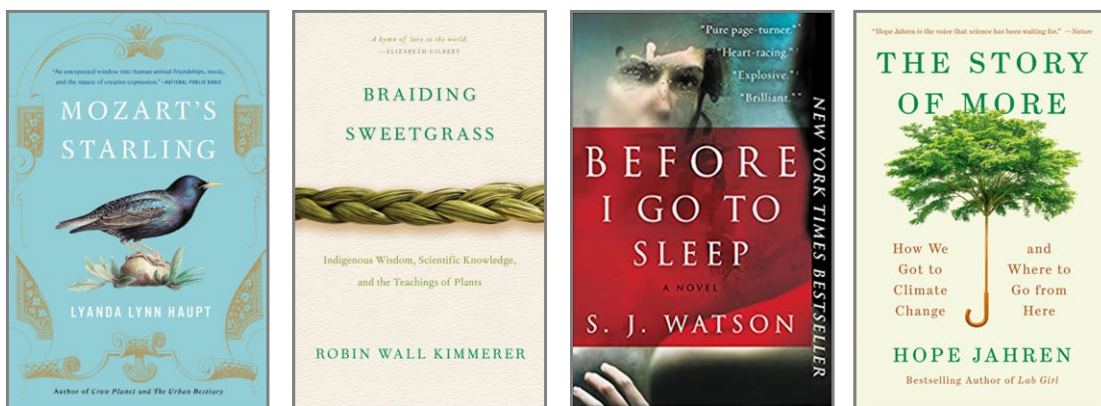
Novel Conversations Book Discussion Group: *Before I Go to Sleep* by S.J. Watson
