Be prepared for Washington State's single-use plastic bag ban, coming into effect October I, with this stylish, reusable, no-sew bag. Pick up a kit at your nearest NOLS branch beginning Friday, September 24, while supplies last. You'll have a fashionable, washable, dryer-able, upcycled bag in no time!

The T-shirt Bag Take & Make Kit includes instructions and one T-shirt from a previous Summer Reading Challenge. All you need is a pair of scissors. Other handy, but optional, supplies include a fabric pen, regular pencil or chalk, and a ruler or straight edge. Check out books from the NOLS collection to make your bag even more spectacular—search the catalog for embroidery, tie-dye, mending, sewing instructions, and more.

Plan ahead now to protect and carry your library materials all winter long! Use a NOLS T-Shirt—or a shirt from home; reusable bags are a better alternative to the 2 billion single-use plastic bags Washingtonians use every year!
