The irony of her situation struck her. She lived in a city with 485 Congressmen, but there wasn't one she could call her's or appeal to for help.
We checked into the matter and were able to direct her to appropriate local agencies that could give some assistance. But the conversation with the welfare agency was dismal. I asked if \$22.50 wasn't a little steep for a one room apartment. The answer was, "That's quite common. You see the landlords generally charge people on welfare a higher rent than they charge anybody else." When I asked for more details of this specific case, the worker revealed that they didn't have any more details. "You see," she explained, "we need a minimum of four case workers in that area of the city but the budget won't allow any."
