Now for the Republicans: As the Democrats fight among themselves, the Republican nomination becomes much more valuable. The greater the chance of GOP election victory, the greater the chance of Nixon winning the nomination. He has the most support within the GOP organization. His greatest handicap was a lack of confidence that he could win. If Republicans felt reasonably certain that this was their year, and that Nixon was among the potential winners. Nixon would get a big boost toward the nomination. His big test will come in Oregon where his popularity probably will be matched against New York Gover-nor Rockefeller.

The political professionals are convinced Rockefeller must go into Oregon to have any hope for the nomination. If he doesn't Nixon will have it sewed up. A pitfall is being prepared for Rockefeller in Neb-raska, which is considered overwhelming for Nixon, and where against his will Rockefeller's name is being placed on the ballot, even though he had it removed. Rockefeller could be hurt in Nebraska just as he was in New Hampshir where a feeble write-in campaign has started on his behalf, even though he disowned it. However, Rockefeller's big primary test will come in Oregon, which is shaping up as an all-star political show for




